The 2010 Marathon Dance will be held on March 5th and 6th at the South Glens Falls Senior High School and is dedicated to the loving memory of Dick Stewart, a significant volunteer who has been loyal to the dance since day one. Opening ceremonies will begin at 7:00 p.m. Friday evening. Community members can donate to the dance in a variety of ways. Each of the **700 students** participating is required to collect a minimum of \$100. In addition to monies collected by the students, members of the community and business owners can donate items to be auctioned during the dance itself.

There are many events held prior to the dance in which money collected at these events is then donated to the Marathon Dance. Some of the events being held prior to the dance include the following:

Much of the money raised is collected at the dance itself. Kip Dare of Kipper's Clippers is organizing the annual cut-a-thon throughout the weekend. Haircuts will be offered for \$10 each with all proceeds being donated to the Marathon Dance. Marathon Dance apparel and photos taken at the dance are sold throughout the event. The annual 50/50 raffle provides an opportunity to be one of the many to win a \$500 prize. The concession stand provides not only baked goods and soda, but through the donations from community members, hot lunch and dinner items. Two of the most popular ways to donate are to be involved in the silent and live actions that take place. The silent auction begins Friday evening and ends early Saturday evening, followed by the live auction which begins at 6:00 p.m.
